The following is a list of volunteer committees and their job descriptions. Please check the areas that you would like to be included i Please note that our veteran volunteers will be there to help you learn as you go. The Friends of Beaver Creek State Park pride themselv to be a enjoying fellowship while volunteering.

\_\_\_\_\_TRADING POST: Our trading post is open Saturday and Sunday from May -Oct from noon-d. Volunteers working the tradii post duties include, unlocking and locking village buildings, greeting visitors and answering questions, and selling goods.

\_\_\_\_\_Mill: Volunteers interested in becoming a miller and working in the mill during Village Comes Alive (first

Saturday of month) Duties include learning how to operate the wheel and grind grains. Other duties include bagging and selling of grain.

\_\_\_\_\_MAINTENANCE: Volunteers needed in maintaining the Village. Special skills are greatly appreciated in construction and electric. General laborers are also needed. Jobs range anywhere from changing light bulbs to building repair.

\_\_\_\_\_SEAMSTRESSES AND CRAFTERS: Seamstresses are needed to make Pioneer Clothing for our volunteers. Materials and Patterns provided. Anyone who is interested in making and donating period related crafts to sell in trading post is also needed.

\_\_\_\_PANCAKE BREAKFAST: Our pancake breakfast is one of our biggest fund raisers. Breakfast is held 3<sup>rd</sup>Sunday of the month May-Oct 8-noon. Duties include preparing food, serving, taking donations and set up and clean up.

\_\_\_\_\_RENTALS: Another major fund raiser involves renting our buildings for private parties. Volunteers are needed to meet wi perspective renters to show the buildings, opening and closing the buildings as well as making sure they are presentable. Contracts a handed out and volunteers keep track of calendar .AII money is handled by Treasurer.

\_\_\_\_\_GARDENING: Volunteers are needed in the planning and planting of a wedding garden to include an arch.

Knowledge of plants is required to be a head of this project. We also need general maintenance of beds.

\_\_\_\_\_GREETERS: Volunteers are needed to greet visitors during the hours that village buildings are open. Duties include greeting visitors, providing information about the village and strolling around making sure no one is stealing anything or smoking in the village. Many visitors are from out of town and enjoy learning about the village, often leading to a donation.

\_\_\_\_\_SCHOOL TOURS: FOBCSP offer school tours. School tours are a great way of getting interest built in to our next generation .School Tours are generally scheduled in May. Duties include providing programs and information as they tour the building. Ideas are welcome to include some hands on activities.

\_\_\_\_\_VILLAGE COMES ALIVE: happens first Sat of the month. Many volunteers are needed for this event. During this time all buildings are open with live demonstrations, including mill operations, blacksmithing, school teaching and anyone who has a skill they can share. Family and children's activities make up a part of the day and volunteers are needed with fresh ideas and help throughout the village. All activities are free to the public as a thank you for their support.
